NU CHAPTER RAMPS UP PHILANTHROPY EFFORTS

On Sunday, October 23, 11 men from the Nu Chapter (2 brothers and 9 pledges) worked with Aquatic Park EGRET, located next to the Berkeley Marina, to help protect the habitats of the egret birds that inhabit the park, and also to improve the usability of the park for visitors. These volunteers were responsible for digging ditches along the banks of the pond at the park, and then placing wood chips into the ditches, in order to help prevent weeds from proliferating and thus causing the area to be inhospitable for the birds.

On Sunday, November 6, 3 men from the Nu Chapter collaborated with Mothers Against Drunk Driving at the Raiders-Broncos NFL game in Oakland. These Tekes walked through the parking lots and handed out fliers to spectators that told of the dangers of drinking and driving, and that urged all spectators to have a designated driver for their ride home from the game. Fans who pledged to be a designated driver for the day received a free soda and were entered into a drawing to potentially win Super Bowl Tickets.
