TKE-NU TO CO-SPONSOR AUTISM SPEAKS U 5K

The Chapter has officially agreed to serve as a co-primary sponsor for the annual Autism Speaks U 5K run on April 7, 2012. The event, officially called "1 in 100 5K Race for Autism U" earns its name the 1 in every 110 people that are diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorders.

Fraters Alexander Bernhart and Ryan Tabura are excited to be working with UC Berkeley Autism Speaks U President Caroline McCloskey to put on this event that raises money to support research for Autism. According to Frater Bernhart, as co-primary sponsors, TKE Nu will "raise \$2000 through registration fees and donations, hold a fundraising BBQ for

[its] sponsors and members, and have 15 of [its] members actually run in the race."
